### Important

We require the exact inside frame to frame measurement's in millimetres for both the width and length as demonstrated in the illustration.

**Do not** take off anything from these measurements.

### Helpful hints

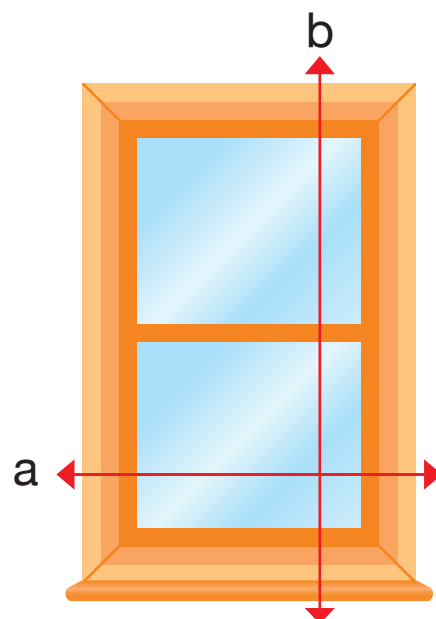
When measuring, always look out for things like window handles, or anything that could obstruct the blinds easy operation. This way you will be sure of a perfect fit.

Always measure width first then length.

Always double check measurements.

**Remember** an open Roman Blind (pulled up) has a stack of 250mm - 300mm depending on the actual full length of the blind, take this into account when measuring. You may want to hand the blind higher to minimise window coverage when open.

### Pros and Cons

- The blind will fold up fully or partialy above the window and will not affect light levels so much.
- You determine the exact size of the blind and where it is fitted.
- They can collect dust along the top of the battons.
- They need to be secured to noggs and studs.
